

Associates Role Description

Experience

Associates are experienced members of the higher education economics community. They will have significant teaching experience in their own departments, typically involving leadership, mentoring of other staff and curriculum development. They will also have a passion for developing and evaluating effective pedagogic innovation.

Responsibilities

The work of the Associates may vary according to the needs and activities of the Network but would typically include:

- Attending Associates meetings
- Present at or facilitate workshops (e.g. GTA, Early Careers, departmental away day)
- Write teaching case studies for our Ideas Bank
- Write articles for our newsletter
- Write, edit or review chapters of the Handbook for Economics Lecturers
- Make a significant contribution to an Economics Network research project, e.g. facilitating EN surveys within departments
- Help with shortlisting papers for the DEE conference or other event(s)

Relationships and contacts

Associates work closely with:

- Senior Associates and other Associates to plan and deliver the Network's activities (e.g. workshops) and provide feedback from the economics HE community
- Economics Network staff for organisation/administrative support (e.g. planning for workshops and research projects)

Expectations

We would expect Associates to:

- Attend annual Associates meetings
- Make a significant annual contribution to the Economics Network, which may include one or more of the activities listed under 'responsibilities' above

Duration of role and renewal

The normal term of office for Associates is 3 years (with a review after the first year). After this time, renewal of an Associate's position for subsequent three-year terms is by mutual agreement with the Network and dependent on continuing contributions as laid out in the 'expectations' section above. The number of terms is not limited.
